FLEX Tickets are general admission tickets that normally retail for \$16.00 per seat and if you purchase a FLEX Ticket from SSYSL you pay ONLY \$13.00 per seat, that's a savings of 19%. A FLEX ticket can be used for any stand alone regular season game. International matches, double and triple headers games with the Revolution are not included. The Revolution Academy

We are thrilled to be hosting the Community Kickers program that offers 12 hours of instruction over 4 days where participants (U8-U12 Boys & Girls) are grouped by age and ability, with the emphasis on individual improvement. The program is led by New England Revolution coaches, players and technical staff, who offer the very best in youth training. The goal for each camper is to develop a "friendship" with the ball and increase involvement in the game. The themes of the week will include individual training, small sided games, and tactical awareness. REGISTRATION CUTOFF is JUNE 1st and we will "NOT" BE TAKING ANY REGISTRATIONS AFTER THIS DATE.

If you don't have your child signed up by June 1st, **DO NOT** call asking if you can get your child registered because we will not be allowing **LATE** Registrations any longer. Please mail your registrations in early and keep a copy of the check. If you register in person at one of our registration days, you will be given a receipt. **Don't give the registration to anyone without getting a receipt.** The check and/or receipt are your proof that you registered your child before the deadline. We basically have a dozen people running a league for over 1,000 children and we need to set a deadline in order for us to focus on the teams we are coaching and our families. We need to stop parents from calling 3 wks into the season asking to get their child registered because they forgot.
